### THE CLASS OF 2007

#### PROFILE FROM THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR

The Office of the Registrar reports the following demographic information regarding the Class of 2007. It is included to provide a useful background for other data contained in this report.

- Between December 2006 and August 2007, 1,656 degrees and certificates were awarded to 1,618 individuals.
- Baccalaureate degrees were awarded to 1,185 graduates: 901 Bachelor of Science; 174 Bachelor of Arts; 47 Bachelor of Social Work; 72 Bachelor of Science in Nursing; 15 Bachelor of General Studies; and 18 Bachelor of Science in Engineering.
- Among the graduates, 94.8 percent identified themselves as of white, non-Hispanic ethnic origin; 4.3 percent of the graduates classified themselves as minorities; and .8 percent as non-resident aliens.
- Among the graduates, 70.3 percent were female, up from 70 percent in 2006.
- 48.45 percent of the graduates were from Gibson, Posey, Vanderburgh, or Warrick counties, while 13.78 percent of degree recipients were from other area counties. Graduates from all other counties in Indiana represented 23 percent of the graduating class; 14.09 percent of the degree recipients were from other states; and .68 percent were from other countries.
- Baccalaureate degrees were awarded by the College of Liberal Arts (30 percent); College of Business (24.4 percent); Bower-Suhrheinrich College of Education and Human Services (20.6 percent); College of Nursing and Health Professions (17.5 percent); Pott College of Science and Engineering (6.2 percent); and Extended Services (1.3 percent).

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY / FOLLOW-UP SURVEY

This report is a six-month follow-up of the 2006-2007 graduating class; responses were received from 55.5 percent of the graduates.

#### **EMPLOYMENT RATES**

- 91.2 percent of the respondents are employed or actively seeking employment. The remaining 8.8 percent are either enrolled in additional academic coursework or have chosen not to seek employment at this time.
- 18.9 percent of the bachelor's degree recipients are enrolled in graduate or professional school. This number, plus the number employed or actively seeking employment, will exceed 100 percent because many new graduates are employed while also pursuing graduate school coursework.
- Of the graduates who are employed, 71.1 percent have secured new positions and 28.9 percent are employed in the same position they held prior to graduation.
- Among bachelor degree recipients who are employed, 89.4 percent are working "in their field or in a field in which they expressed satisfaction", a slight decrease from 90.9 percent in 2006. (Education majors employed as substitute teachers are coded as working "in their field".) Among ALL graduates employed, 89.7 percent are working in their field of study (2006 figure = 90.45 percent). Overall, these numbers have not changed significantly in the past two years.

- Among <u>all</u> bachelor degree recipients, the number of underemployed (i.e. working in a field unrelated to their career goals) is 8.9 percent. Among bachelor degree recipients who are employed, the total number of underemployed bachelor graduates is 11.9 percent.
- There were 39 (5.8 percent of the total respondents) bachelor graduates unemployed (not working and not enrolled in additional coursework or attending graduate school but seeking employment).

#### CONTINUED EDUCATION

- Among bachelor degree recipients who completed the questionnaire, 18.6 percent were attending graduate school within a year of graduation, up 2.2 percent from 2006 (16.4 percent).
- Among associate degree recipients, 27.4 percent are currently completing requirements for a baccalaureate degree, down 9.8 percent from 2006 (37.2 percent).
- Among bachelor degree recipients, 2.7 percent are enrolled in additional undergraduate coursework. The percentage remains the same as in 2006.

#### **GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION**

- Among all employed graduates, 71.1 percent accepted employment within the tri-state (a 60mile radius of the University), a decrease of 2.1 percent from 2006 (73.2 percent). Sixty of these individuals reside in Kentucky or Illinois.
  - 28.2 percent of the employed bachelor degree recipients left the tri-state area in 2007, a 14 percent increase from 2006 (14.2 percent).
  - 33.9 percent of the employed master degree recipients left the tristate area in 2007, an increase of 8.1 percent from 2006 (25.8 percent).
  - 20.2 percent of the employed associate degree recipients left the tri-state in 2007, a 1.3 percent increase from 2006 (18.9 percent).
- Among all 2007 graduates, 16.8 percent left the tri-state to accept employment elsewhere in Indiana (13 percent in 2006), bringing the total number of 2007 graduates who work and utilize services in Indiana to 87.8 percent. If the 60 Illinois and Kentucky residents are subtracted from the tri-state figure, the state retention rate for 2007 employed USI graduates was 80.1 percent, compared to 78.3 percent in 2006.

#### SALARY STATISTICS

- The average starting salary for baccalaureate degree graduates securing NEW, FULL-TIME POSITIONS was \$32,907, a 3.1 percent decrease over the average starting salary of \$33,947 in 2006.
- The average starting salary for associate degree graduates securing NEW, FULL-TIME POSITIONS was \$41,693, an increase of 33.9 percent from the average starting salary of \$31,140 in 2006.
