I Undergraduate minor and course deletion petition

Herring submitted petitions to delete the four minor titles of <u>Advertising</u>, <u>Computer Publishing</u>, <u>Communications</u>, and <u>Public Relations</u>. Kearns was concerned that the University Curriculum Committee would ask about the loss of the minors. Just because we do not have a major, will there not be a need for the minor? Herring said that the courses the students would need for the minor no longer exist, so they would not be able to fulfill the requirements. Herring also submitted to delete the undergraduate course of <u>Independent Study in Computer Publishing</u>. There is no longer a major in Computer Publishing.

It was moved and seconded to remove the minors and the Independent Study course. All were in favor of the deletion.
