THE CLASS OF 2002

PROFILE FROM THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR

The Office of the Registrar reports the following demographic information regarding the Class of 2002. We include it to provide a useful background for other data contained in this report.

- Between December 2001 and August 2002, 1357 degrees and certificates were awarded to 1339 individuals.
- Baccalaureate degrees were awarded to 1010 graduates; 792 Bachelor of Science degrees, 130 Bachelor of Arts, 39 Bachelor of Social Work, 39 Bachelor of Science in Nursing, and 10 Bachelor of General Studies.
- 96.7% of the graduates identified themselves as white, non-Hispanic ethnic origin. 2.9% of the graduates classified themselves as minorities and .4% as non-resident aliens.
- 65.8% of the graduates were female, down from 66.9% in 2001.
- Graduates whose county of origin was Gibson, Posey, Vanderburgh or Warrick received 50.4% of the degrees, while 15.1% of degree recipients were from other area counties. Graduates from all other counties in Indiana represented 21.6% of the graduating class; 12.5% of the degree recipients were from other states; .4% were from other countries.
- 32% of the baccalaureate degrees were awarded by the School of Liberal Arts, followed by the School of Business (23.9%), the School of Education and Human Services (22.3%), the School of Nursing and Health Professions (12.2%), the School of Science and Engineering Technology (8.6%), and Extended Services (1%).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY / FOLLOW-UP SURVEY

This report is a six-month follow-up of the 2001-2002 graduating class; responses were received from 56% of the graduates.

EMPLOYMENT RATES

- 93.1% of the respondents are employed or actively seeking employment. The remaining 6.9% are either enrolled in additional academic coursework or have chosen not to seek employment at this time.
- The graph on page three of this report indicates that 18.1% of the bachelor's degree recipients are enrolled in graduate or professional school. This number plus the number employed or actively seeking employment will exceed 100% because many new graduates are employed while pursuing graduate school coursework.
- Of the graduates who are employed, 71.7% have secured new positions; 28.3% are employed in the same position that they held prior to graduation.

- Among bachelor's degree recipients who are employed, 88.1% are employed "in their field", down from 90.7% in 2001. (Education majors employed as substitute teachers are coded as working "in their field".) Among ALL graduates employed, 89.8% are employed in their field of study (2001 figure = 92.7%). This slight decrease is to be expected due to the events in the latter part of 2001 which had a profound impact upon employment opportunities.
- The number of underemployed bachelor graduates (i.e. working in a field unrelated to their career goals) stands at 9.7%.
- There were 28 (5.1%) bachelor graduates unemployed (not working and not attending additional coursework or graduate school but seeking employment). *A less-than-robust job market has made it more difficult for graduates to obtain employment even outside their career field.*

CONTINUED EDUCATION

- 18.1% of the bachelor's degree recipients who completed the questionnaire were attending graduate school within a year of graduation, up 2.7% from 2001. *The soft job market may have convinced some graduates who would otherwise have entered the job market to pursue graduate study instead.*
- 45.2% of the associate's degree recipients are currently completing requirements for a baccalaureate degree, down from 46.8% in 2001.
- 2.7% of the bachelor's degree recipients are enrolled in additional undergraduate coursework, a decrease of 3.9% from one year ago (6.6%).

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

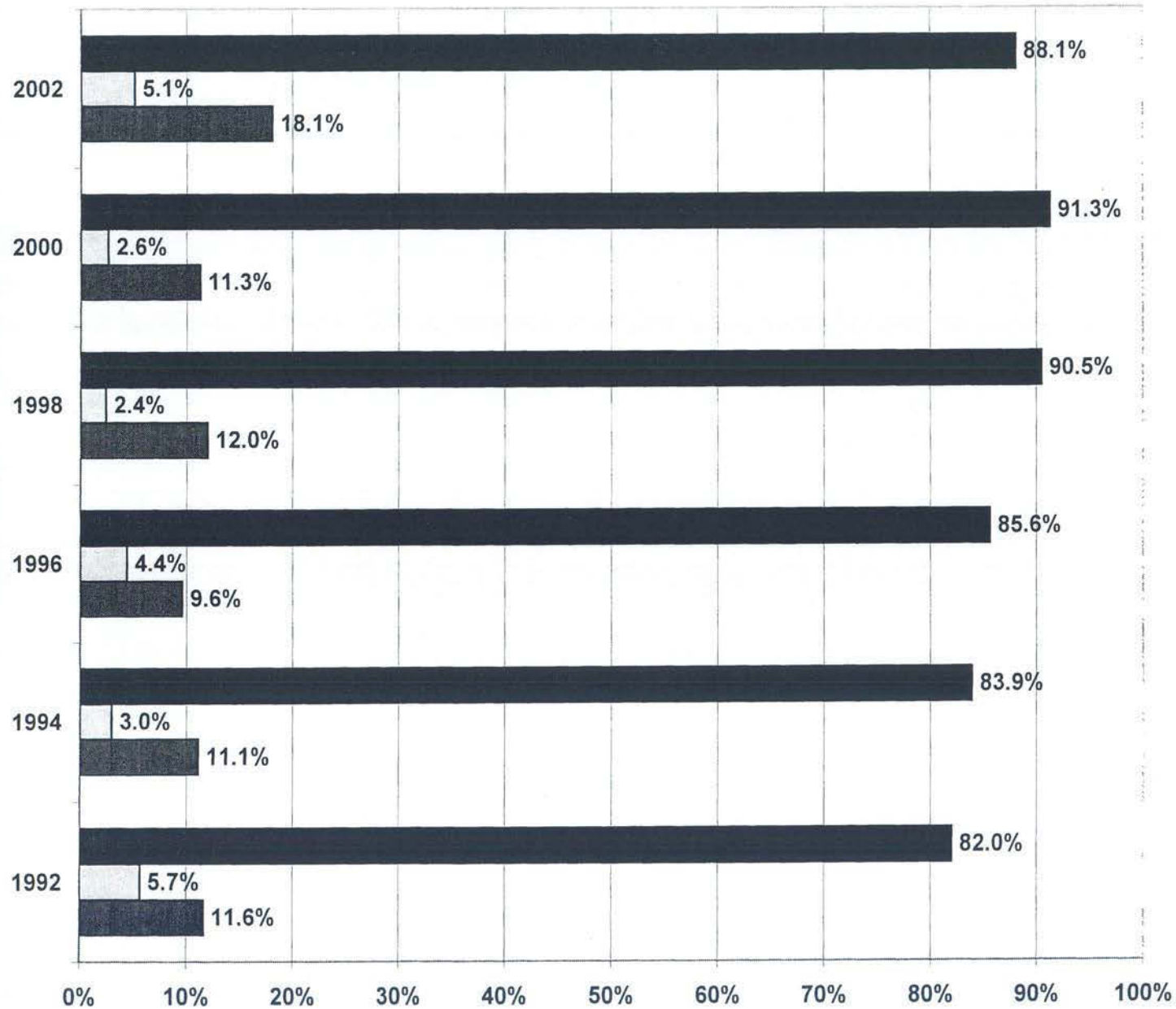
- 78.3% of the graduates accepted employment within a 60-mile radius of the University, a 5.6% increase from 2001. (49 of these individuals reside in Kentucky or Illinois.) 25.3% of the employed bachelor's degree recipients left the tri-state area, down slightly from the 30.2% who relocated in 2001. Among employed master's degree recipients, relocation decreased from 10.2% to 6%. Employed 2002 associate degree recipients were less mobile; 18.6% relocated, compared to 23.4% in 2001.
- 12.3% of the graduates left the tri-state to accept employment elsewhere in Indiana, bringing the total number of 2002 graduates who work and utilize services in Indiana to 90.6%. Even if the 49 Illinois and Kentucky residents are subtracted from the tri-state figure, the state retention rate for 2002 USI graduates is 83.1%.

SALARY STATISTICS

- The average starting salary for baccalaureate degree graduates securing **NEW, FULL-TIME POSITIONS** was \$28,790, a .8% increase over the average starting salary of \$28,564 in 2001.
- Associate degree salaries (**NEW, FULL-TIME POSITIONS**) increased more substantially, averaging \$31,593, a 4.3% increase over the \$30,247 reported in 2001. Since most associate degree recipients graduate from the School of Nursing and Health Professions (fields in high demand) it is not surprising that, on average, associate degree salaries are higher than those for recipients of 4-year, non-technical degrees.

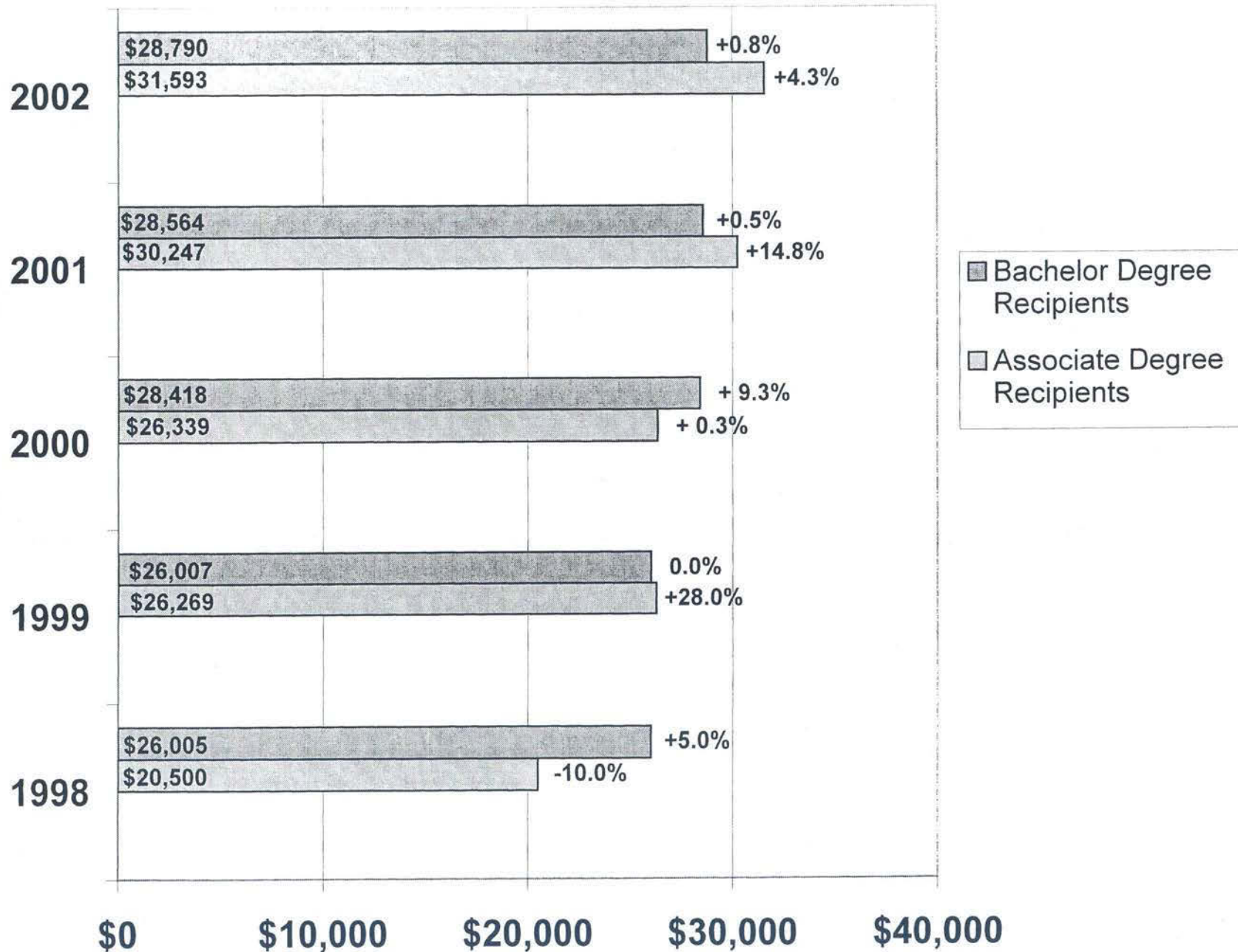
