## The Formal Research Paper

## Assignment:

The formal research paper/project should include the following:

- 1. A cover page
- 2. Abstract = a one-two page condensation of the revised Proposal
- 3. Table of Contents
- 4. The body of the paper with appropriate citations for sources
- 5. Illustrations/Figures/Supplemental Material (e.g., surveys) clearly marked
- 6. Endnotes = additional commentary that doesn't necessarily belong in the paper as such, but which is interesting enough for you to want to add for the reader's information.
- 7. A "Works Cited" or "Bibliography", depending on your documentation style.

## Specs:

Draft: Seven – eight pages (not including cover, abstract, table of contents, or

supplemental material); include a hard copy for Peer Review

Revision: Ten – twelve pages (not including cover, abstract, table of contents, or

supplemental material)

Margins: One-inch margins on all sides

Spacing: Double-space throughout.

Page #s: Number all pages
