They are very interested in collaborating with us and will set up a Webex to go into more details with USI's plans. We are determining the feasibility of offering this program to our present CIS and CS students, our alumni, and non-degree-seeking students.

Curriculum-related activities,

1) We will implement the three tracks for CIS Majors this fall—Enterprise Web Development, Application Development, and IS Management.

2) We have updated the Post Baccalaureate in CIS so that students can choose between the above three tracks.

3) The Minor in Web Development will be implemented beginning this fall. Brochures have been produced and distributed, and the Minor has been promoted with students in the COB and in the College of Liberal Arts.

4) Currently, we are discussing revision of CIS261 and a change in CIS111 so that CIS students will only have to take CIS111 instead of taking CIS111 AND CIS305.

5) A position for CS was approved and recruitment is underway for that position. Scott Anderson and Jennifer Williams are chairing this effort.
