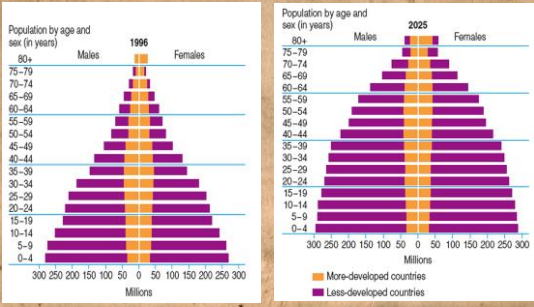

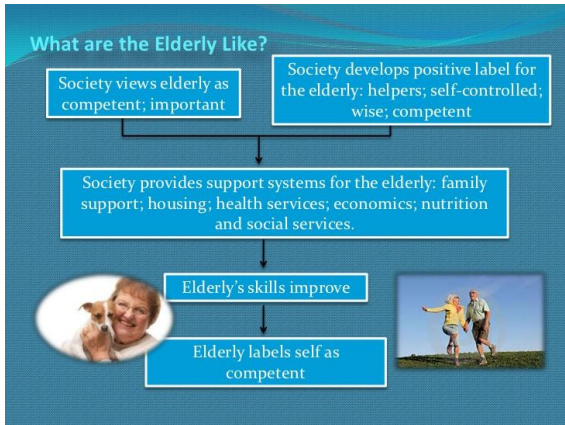

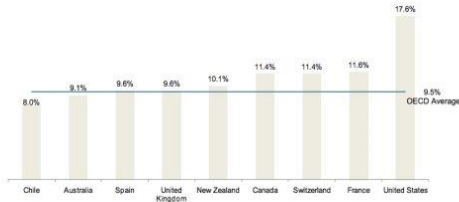

2010 Health Spending as Percent of GDP

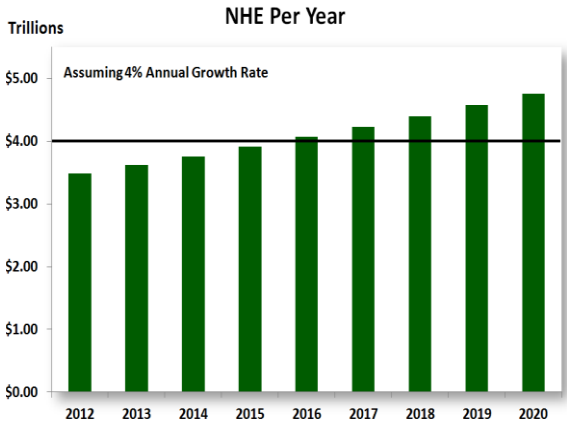


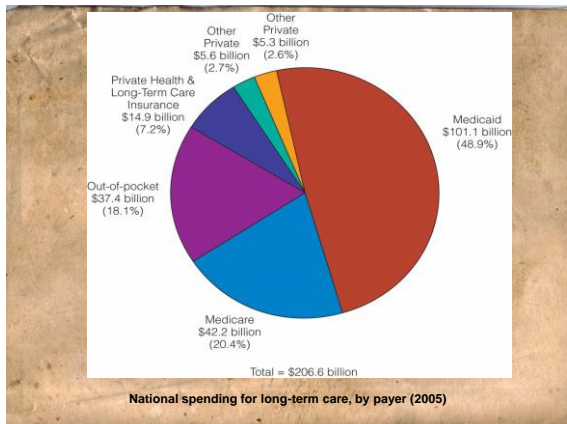

Estimates of future demand for long-term care (in millions)

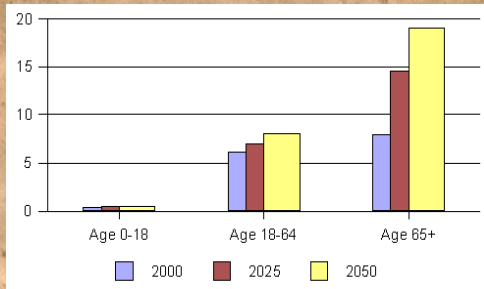
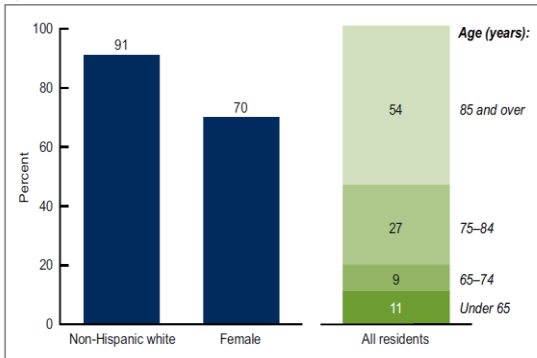


Figure 1. Selected characteristics of residential care residents: United States, 2010

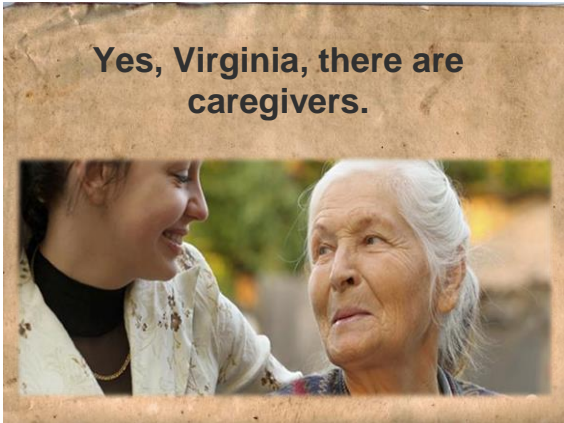

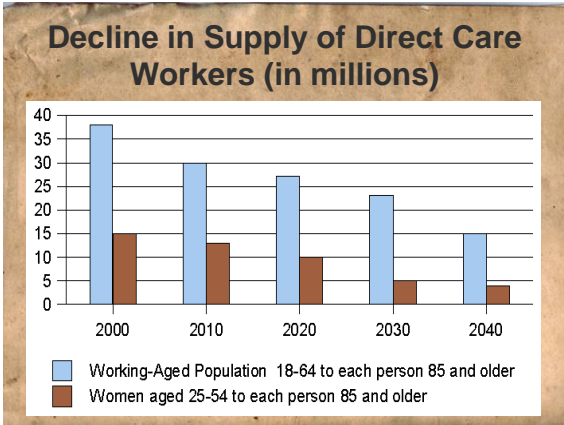


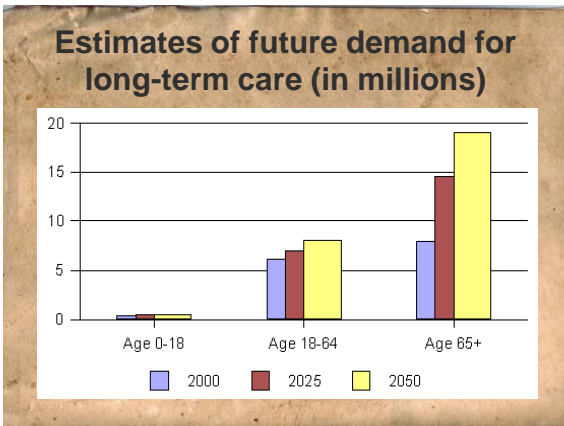


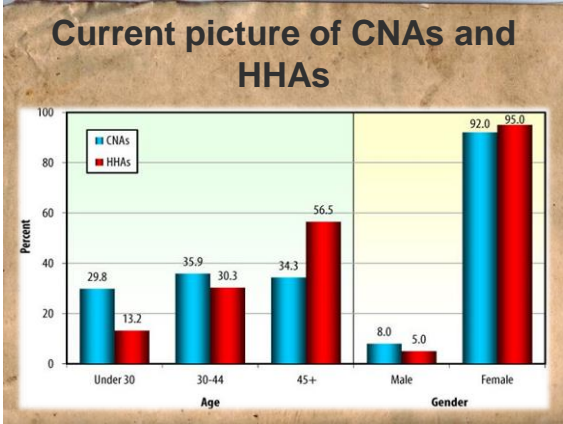
Projected Physician Supply and Demand:
Baseline and Alternative Scenario*, 2006–2025

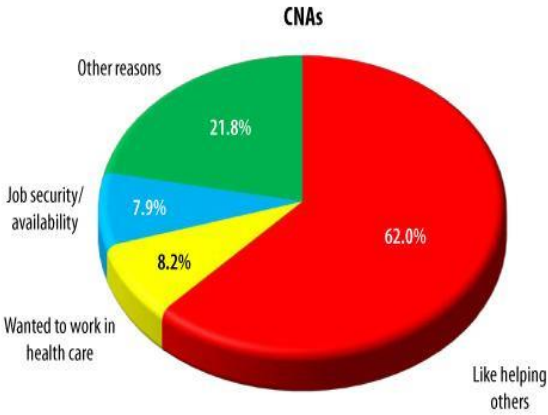


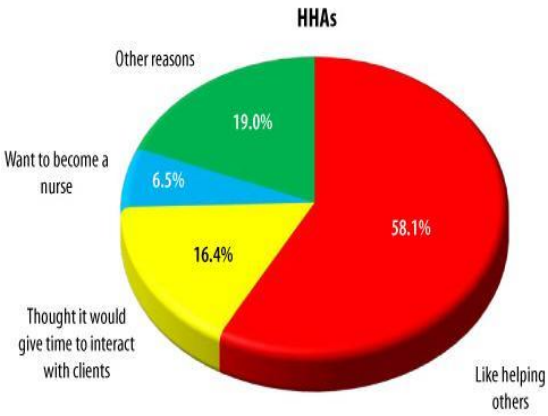
