## Incoming Student Enrollment

Over the past 10 years, the total number of incoming undergraduates has grown by $4.4 \%$, from 2,676 in fall 2001 to 2,795 in fall 2010. The number of incoming graduate students has increased slightly from 255 in fall 2003, to 259 in fall 2010*.

## Graduation Rates

Compared with the fall 2000 cohort, the fall 20064 -year graduation rate has risen by $2.6 \%$ points. The cumulative 6 -year rate has decreased slightly from $33.2 \%$ to $32.5 \%$ for the fall 2004 cohort.
