The selected candidate will be responsible for assisting and supporting the ThunderBolts with video production, video streaming, and radio broadcasting.

Job Functions and Responsibilities:

Radio Broadcasting focus includes:

- Assist talent and staff with production of on-air programming & keep game statistics
- Ensure advertisements and endorsements are queued and ready for broadcasts.
- Maintain the digital and internet based aspect of the show.
- Update & maintain team websites and social media.

Video Production focus includes:

- Create digital promotional and advertising materials from story board to final product.
- Hands on use of video camera and video editing.
- Ensure video spots are queued and replayed as appropriate during home games.

Video Streaming focus includes:

Set-up, operate and maintain FastHockey equipment for online streaming of home games.

Qualifications:

- Candidates should be seeking an Associates or Bachelor's degree in Broadcasting, Media Production, Sports Management, Communications or related field.
- Must have excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Knowledge and experience with Microsoft Office 365.
- Strong attention to detail and organizational skills.
