Biology Lounge

- Rough draft layout:
 - 50-50 split of tables/chairs & soft seating
 - Glass doors
 - bottom frosted but the top clear [semi-private]
 - 2 computers at the front
 - big bookshelf along wall
 - Option 1:
 - Front: few lounge chairs
 - Middle: three 2-person moveable tables & chairs
 - Back: 2 large circle couches
 - Option 2:
 - Front & middle: same chairs/layout
 - Back: more movable furniture, only one couch, and more chairs
 - Whiteboard walls [definite keep]
 - Niche that has access to a dark room as well as an emergency exit [required for safety]
- Suggestions:
 - mini fridge and microwave
 - Printer next to computer station
 - Thought: printer in storage cabinet to maximize space
 - Cubby space for backpacks/coats in bookshelves against wall
 - Main feedback: would like to see more tables and chairs, less lounging furniture
 - Focus on homework & study groups
 - Whiteboard tables?
 - Power cord tower to charge phones, with chargers
 - Switch the arrangement and have the public space in the front and hard core studying in the back
 - This way it won't be as distracting for the people who are studying to have people constantly coming and going
 - TV in the lounge area to stream things from computer (similar to Library)
 - Utilizes the place as comfortable, but also functional
 - Rolling chairs in middle section
- About 18x25 ft (rough estimate)
- Completion: shooting to be done sometime in the fall (mid fall)
- Other USI design changes/suggestions
 - Getting new chairs in the math lecture rooms
 - No more swivel chairs

- \circ $\,$ More perch-chairs in the first and second levels of the SC $\,$
 - Outside of the departments
- Squeaky tables in the math/chemistry lounge
- Furniture like what's in the Redwood lounge in the first floor of the SC under the stairs and next to the forum room in the front
- Charging station in the Pott college advising center
- Cubbies in the lobby of the ED/SC
 - Behind the stairs in the ED/SC building
 - Set up like the locking phone charging stations
 - Possibly automatically unlock after 24 hours, so people are discouraged from leaving their stuff for days at a time
- More tables outside by cone
 - Bigger tables
 - Tall tables
 - Charging station outside?
- Upcoming changes to campus
 - Path/sidewalk to applied engineering building in the works
 - PAC phase 1 is scheduled to be done at end of the year
 - Welcome center completed Fall 2018
 - \circ $\,$ PAC phase 2 is to start this year and hopefully end next year $\,$
 - New residence hall in the 2-3 years [master plan]
 - Lower level of the library renovation [3 years?]
 - Update furniture, light fixtures, etc.
