PROGRAM CURRICULUM

Courses within both certificates are offered entirely online using a learning management system. Access to a reliable computer with internet access is required. All courses within the certificates are three credit hours long.

The 12-credit hour certificate has two required courses (six credit hours) and two COMM 600-level electives.

The 18-credit hour, advanced certificate has three required courses (nine credit hours) and three COMM 600-level electives.

NOTE: You cannot obtain both an Instructional Communication certificate and the Advanced Instructional Communication certificate.

Courses are designed using the Quality Matters Rubric Standards based on best practices and research for course design.
