PROGRAM CURRICULUM

The Master of Science in Education program consists of 33 credit hours. Each concentration within the MSE curriculum is comprised of two to three segments: required core courses, electives, and a research sequence. Courses within the MSE range from 1 to 3 credit hours. Specific concentration curriculums can be viewed on the MSE website.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be admitted to a graduate study under University graduate policies and then be accepted into the specific MSE concentration track. In addition to the requirements for admission to graduate study at USI, admission to the MSE program requires the following:

- A baccalaureate degree (minimum cumulative GPA 2.75) from an accredited college or university with a degree in education or a related field
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 in all courses taken at the graduate level at all schools attended
- A copy of a standard U.S. teaching license or an approved waiver form
- A completed personal information form that includes a record of teaching experience



Teacher preparation programs are approved by the Indiana Department of Education and are accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation.
