PROGRAM CURRICULUM

The online RRT to BSRT has the ability to be completed within four semesters or less, contingent upon transferred courses. All courses within the RRT to BSRT are seven weeks long. We will create an individualized plan of study that integrates your previously earned college credits from your RRT education.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of an associate degree in a CoARC accredited respiratory therapy program and regional accreditation of the college or university
- Cumulative GPA average of a 2.3 on a 4.0 scale; students with a 2.0-2.29 will be considered on an individual basis
- RRT credential through the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC)
- Completion of the USI RRT-BSRT undergraduate application
- Submission of official transcripts from all colleges attended
