## Post-Master's Certificate in Educational Leadership and Administration

The purpose of the program is to transform leaders, organizations, and communities through focused, flexible study addressing realworld problems and issues. Academic study is connected to concepts, issues, and content that are familiar, understandable, accessible, and personally relevant to each student. In each course, students will apply learning in practical, real-life settings. The program of study includes a 24-credit hour program in administrative leadership that includes an internship.

#### **PROGRAM DELIVERY**

Courses within the certificate program are offered entirely online using a learning management system. You will need access to a reliable computer with internet.

### HOW YOU WILL BENEFIT FROM THE PROGRAM

The program is designed to prepare P-12 educators for leadership roles in P-12 school corporations/districts with summer and fall admission cycles. P-12 education is a common theme throughout the program to prepare educators for entry as principals and assistant principals. Upon the completion of the 24-credit hour program, the passage of the required licensure test, and the required teaching experience, graduates may be eligible for an Indiana Building-Level Administrator License.

#### **PROGRAM CURRICULUM**

Courses are delivered online in a 7-week, bi-term format. Students take two classes each semester with a short break in the summer. The courses are delivered in an online format allowing students from a distance to complete the program. The program unfolds over two years but can be designed to be completed in one year.

#### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants need to complete a USI Graduate Studies Application, including a nonrefundable \$40 fee paid to Graduate Studies.

#### All applicants must have:

• A baccalaureate degree from a regionally-accredited institution with a cumulative grade-point average of 2.75 or higher

#### **Program Requirements:**

- Maintain a 2.75 or higher grade-point average at USI
- Earn a grade C or better in all required courses in the program

• A valid Indiana teaching license
