Graduate Certificate for Teacher License Addition in Exceptional Needs: Mild Intervention

The purpose of the program is to prepare current teachers to teach exceptional students with mild disabilities in grades P-12. Academic study is connected to concepts, issues, and content that are familiar, understandable, accessible, and personally relevant to each student. In each course, students will apply learning in practical, real-life settings.

PROGRAM DELIVERY

Courses within the certificate program are offered entirely online using a learning management system. You will need access to a reliable computer with internet.

HOW YOU WILL BENEFIT FROM THE PROGRAM

Our affordable and convenient program gives you control over your schedule. The program is designed to prepare P-12 educators on an emergency license teaching in special education or seeking add-on endorsement. Upon the completion of the 24 credit hour program and the passage of the required Indiana content licensure test, graduates may be eligible for license addition in P-12 Exceptional Needs: Mild Intervention.



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PROGRAM CURRICULUM

Students take two classes each semester with a short break in the summer. The courses are delivered in an online format allowing students from a distance to complete the program. The program unfolds over four semesters but could be designed to be completed in as little as three semesters.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants need to complete a USI Graduate Studies Application, including a nonrefundable \$40 fee paid to Graduate Studies.

All applicants must have:

- A baccalaureate degree from a regionally-accredited institution with a cumulative grade-point average of 2.75 or higher
- A valid Indiana teaching license

Program Requirements:

- Maintain a 2.75 or higher grade-point average at USI
- Earn a grade C or better in all required courses in the program
