
Courses within the MPA Program are offered entirely online using a learning management system. You will need access to a reliable computer with internet.

Program Curriculum

The MPA program consists of 36 credit hours that includes a core curriculum of seven courses (21 hours), and either **A)** a capstone seminar (3 hours) plus 12 hours of electives, or **B)** a thesis project (6 hours) plus 9 hours of electives.

Each certificate consists of just four classes (12 hours) and can be completed while working full time.

Admission Requirements

Applicants seeking to be admitted to the Master of Public Administration program generally hold a bachelor's degree (any major is acceptable) with at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale. Students with less than a 3.0 GPA may be admitted on a conditional basis upon review by the admissions committee.
