- Follow up to last meeting's discussion with Rice Library
 - o RL is working into expanding hours of operation
 - Buckets of cleaning supplies have become more spread out around the library
 - Computer labs are open for use with reservation of a space
 - Other issues discussed are being looked into
- Survey Update
 - Over 300 surveys were completed
 - Quantitative results
 - Lab equipment seems to be rated between great and good
 - Instagram is the most popular social media option
 - 60% says the Pott College Campus Community social media is useful
 - 98% of people say they feel safe in labs
 - 89% feel safe in in person classes
 - A majority of people say they feel safe in the lounge areas
 - 75% of people said that they did not have problems finding a place in between classes to study
 - 88% says that they feel the college has take proper health precautions
 - 15% of submissions said they would want to be a part of an SAB meeting
 - o Qualitative results
 - Equipment problems in Pott College
 - Biology and Chemistry chairs
 - Dissection kits
 - Glassware for chemistry
 - Cracked Microscope Slides
 - Students are not feeling safe in labs because people are not wearing their masks properly
 - Should investigate equipment not being sanitized between uses
 - One on one time with professors has been drastically reduced
 - Some felt that online classes assign too much work
 - Some felt that in person should be optional for classes
 - People want more sanitation stations in areas other than classes
 - People were concerned with not being able to have guests in housing
 - Random covid 19 testing on campus should be explored
 - We should look into allowing more housing students to park on campus during class
 - Especially when it is raining/snowing
 - Wifi is a big issue on campus this year
 - This is preventing classes from working as desired
 - Future Guest Ideas
 - IT department
 - Only issue so far is wifi problems
