- An idea for a bill is proposed A legislator in the house or senate sponsors it
- A draft of the bill is written
- The draft is assigned to a committee

- When both house and senate have a majority vote, the bill is passed.
- It goes to the governor to be signed, not signed and passed in seven days without action, or
- vetoed. When vetoed, it can be passed without signature
