## **Admission Requirements:**

 Submit complete application to the University of Southern Indiana Master of Social Work Program:

- Minimum cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0;
- Provide 3 strong academic or professional references;
- Provide Resume/CV;
- Provide Personal Statement;
- Submit application to Graduate Studies and pay \$40 non-refundable application fee: <a href="https://www.usi.edu/graduatestudies/admission-to-graduate-programs">https://www.usi.edu/graduatestudies/admission-to-graduate-programs</a>;
- Complete all prerequisites before beginning the program
- Any discipline may enter the program. Prerequisites include six social science classes (18 credit hours), plus foundation statistics and research courses (for prerequisite listing see <a href="https://www.usi.edu/socialwork">www.usi.edu/socialwork</a>).
- Psychology, sociology, and criminal justice majors usually meet all admissions requirements.
- Students with a non-social work
  degree will take 61 credit hours,
  completing 17 classes and two
  internships for the degree. There is a generalist internship and a clinical internship.
- This is a full-time program with day classes.
   It will take two years to complete.
