Dietetic Internship Match Information (Fall 2022)

Pre-match - Students are encouraged to release their names on D&D Digital

(<u>www.dnddigital.com/ada/index.php</u>) at in the event they are not matched so that their name will be available to the DI Program directors during the Interim Selection Period.

<u>Match day (First round match)</u> – Students have access to the match list on the date listed on D&D Digital 6:00 pm Central Time. Students should notify the DI director of their acceptance of or rejection from the internship program within 24 hours of match notification (before 6 pm in the time zone of the program the Monday after match day).

Interim Selection Period -

- Between 12:01 pm CST Tuesday until 8:00 pm CST Wednesday, students who had previously been ranked by an internship but were not originally matched may be contacted by an internship and offered an internship spot. *Once students accept an offer, it is important to commit to the offer and not back out if another position is offered to them.*
- Interim selection period ends at 8:00 pm CST Wednesday.

<u>Second Round selection</u> –On Thursday at 11 am CST, non-matched applicants will have access to the list of DI program openings including ISPPs.

- Students not matched in the first round should refer to their selected DI program's websites to
 identify the individual programs' second round selection procedures. If no information is listed
 on the websites, students should call or email the DI Program Directors of programs that list
 open spots to obtain the appropriate steps they should take to apply in the second round
 selection.
- Students are required to pay \$20 to DICAS for each program they apply to in the second round selection. Students who are submitting a DICAS application for the first time will be required to pay \$45 for their first application and \$20 for each additional application.
- Applicants have access to the list of programs that have openings listed on D&D Digital.
- DI Directors of programs with openings will begin accepting applications.
- Students participating in the second round selection should review the DI program website and follow the procedures that are listed.
- Students should only apply in the second round to DI programs they feel fit their professional goals.

12:00 pm CST, 6 days after match day:

• Applications for the second round selection due, with the common invitation deadline for second round selection.

• Some programs may choose to accept submissions after the common invitation deadline set above. Students should refer to the programs' webpages to learn whether they have a later deadline.

At 11:00 am CST, Thursday, 11 days after match day

- DI directors will begin inviting students into their programs *after* Thursday at 11 am, 11 days after match day.
- Students should be prepared to receive communication from a DI Director with an invitation to their DI program. *Students should accept the first offer given to them as opposed to waiting to see if they get a better offer*.
- Students who receive an invitation for a DI position and accept the position should immediately inform their DPD Director.
